## **2019 CALLS NUMBERS ARE IN**

End of the year numbers are in. CAD transactions for the county are slightly down from last year, by about 6%. 50,264 calls for service have been entered into the CAD in 2019. 9-1-1 calls are up by about 2% from last year. Current 9-1-1 calls coming into the center are 36,213. 7-Digit line calls are up over 7% from the same time last year, as 82,216 7-Digit calls have been received here.

## **BELMONT COUNTY OVERDOSES REPORTED**

These are the overdoses reported to 9-1-1 countywide for all of 2019. In 2018, we had 142 reported overdoses. Monthly breakdown for 2019 is as follows:

#### BELMONT COUNTY RADIO SYSTEM UPGRADES

Bearcom is finalizing the installation of the new equipment for the Paging and Microwave system upgrades. Most of this work was completed in December. There are still a few things needing done on their list, but the system upgrades are progressing nicely.

The addition of two frequencies to use on our 800 MHz P25 Radio System is also in progress. This will help to increase the capacity of the system, so that during the busiest periods, users will have less "busies" when attempting to communicate. The frequencies are now in the system, but not turned on yet. Prior to turning these on for use, all radios must be reprogrammed, and additional equipment added so that the frequencies can be recorded.

The system software has been updated to the most recent version of Motorola software (Version 2019). This will allow our system to expand and offer new features, while maintaining compliance with Motorola's annual maintenance program. Each mobile and portable radio will need to be updated with additional software, so that they may utilize some of the new enhancements. In the very near future, we will be contacting ALL departments to schedule your radios for reprogramming.

All of these upgrades will be paid with funds from the 9-1-1 Radio System Upgrade Levy. Without this levy, none of these upgrades and enhancements would be possible.

#### **ACTIVE 9-1-1**

I need to reiterate that 9-1-1 does not administer the Active 9-1-1 system or app. We merely fund it for the responders of Belmont County. If you are having issues with the app, need your "Code", have problems downloading the app or have any general questions, we urge you to first contact your department's Chief. If they can't resolve your issue, you may try to contact Jim Delman or Allan Ketzell, from the Belmont County Fire & Squad Officer's Association. The Association is the one who administers Active 9-1-1 in the county.

#### RADIO REPAIRS AND REMOVALS

All radio repairs and mobile radio removal from vehicles of county owned equipment MUST go through 9-1-1 directly. We will make contact with BearCom (Staley's), approve the repair or removal and pay for the work. It is simple, call our office and speak to Bryan Minder, Jim Delman or Tony Gregor. We will take care of the rest. Please DO NOT remove any mobile radio yourself. Most times critical, and expensive, wiring is left behind, causing additional cost to us when the radio gets reinstalled into another vehicle. Also, whenever possible, we ask that you try to take your vehicle to the BearCom shop in Wheeling for any radio work. It is an additional charge for us to have a Technician travel to you. We understand that sometimes this is not possible, but when it is, please help us out in order to save on repair costs.

#### BELMONT COUNTY CISM IS ALWAYS AVAILABLE

Just a reminder to all departments, Belmont County has access to Critical Incident Stress Management teams to help your members 24/7. CISM can be accessed by calling the EMA at 740-695-5984 or by calling into dispatch at 740-699-0425 to request it. All requests are kept confidential.
