2023 CALL NUMBERS FOR THE COUNTY

At the end of this newsletter, you will see the call numbers for all departments, as well as the call volume handled by Central and Martins Ferry PSAPs. Total numbers for Fire and Law responses were down 1448 from 2022 numbers (49139 vs 50587). As for call volume throughout the county, 9-1-1 calls were up 586 over 2022, at 32692 totals calls and CAD transactions were up 1326, with 55198 total for 2023. 7-digit calls were down slightly at 61579, about 1892 less than 2022. All in all, it was a very busy year for public safety forces countywide. Kudos for everyone answering the call.

DISPATCHER CHANGES AT 9-1-1

We would like to welcome two new full-time dispatchers at 9-1-1. First is Lanee Yocum. She has completed training and is working her full time shift already. Lanee has previous dispatching experience at the Barnesville Police Department, where she dispatched part time. Lanee takes over for Tyler Lovey, who has gone to part-time status from a full-time position. Next is Wilbert "Chip" Sattler. Chip is a retired corrections officer from BeCI. He will be taking the place of Cali Brudzinski, who resigned her position. Chip is still in training and hopes to be finished sometime later this month.

911 WIRELESS CHANGING TO NEXT GEN 911 FUND

To the right, you will see that we update you with the money coming in from the State of Ohio for "Wireless 911" funding. In 2024, those funds will be changed over from Wireless 911 funds to "Next Generation 911" funds. The Wireless Fund will go away and be replaced with the new funding source. This money is to be used by each county to mover forward towards NextGen 9-1-1 services, as they become available statewide (and nationwide). NextGen is a move to utilize new technology to improve 9-1-1 services, such as improved caller location, text-to-911, video-to-911, and the IP backbone that will run the entire 9-1-1 system nationwide. As those new numbers are received, we will continue to provide you with updates.

RADIO REPROGRAMMING TO BEGIN SOON

BearCom hopes to begin doing radio reprogramming in the next month or two. This will be a long process, as each radio will need to be read, flash updated and then reprogrammed again with a new template. They will begin to contact Police and Fire Chiefs to get them on the schedule. Please be patient with the Techs, as this involves an extended programming period. One good part of this project will be the addition of "Over-the Air" programming through Radio Management. Meaning, we will be able to do some future reprogramming remotely, so that radios don't have to be "touched" every time changes are needed. Additionally, if you have radios owned by your department, purchased by a previous grant or otherwise but not owned by us, we are going to make arrangements later to have those flash updated for you. We will pay the cost for that update, but it was not included in this part of the radio upgrade project.
